Amendment 1 to Notice of Race

Replace 4.1.

4.1. The event is open to all boats of the Ruffian 23 class that comply with the Ruffian 23 Class Rules.

Add 4.2 and renumber the remaining instructions of this section.

4.2. Each Entrant must be a paid up member of the Irish Ruffian Association, be that a full or temporary member. Membership can be paid online at www.ruffians.ie.

Amend date and time for 6.1

6.1. Briefing: Thursday 25th June at 1800

Add Olympic Triangle to 9.1

9.1. The course(s) to be sailed will be as follows: Windward/Leeward or Olympic Triangle.

Change 2 to 4 for 11.1

11.1. Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series

Replace all of 16

16.1. Overall series prizes will be awarded to:

(a) 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in the Gold Fleet.

(b) 1st place in the Silver Fleet.

16.2 For the purpose of overall prizes, the final fleet will be divided into Gold and Silver fleets based on the final overall series ranking list. The top half of the ranking list will form the Gold Fleet and the remaining half will form the Silver Fleet. If there is an odd number of total entries, the middle-placed boat on the ranking list will be assigned to the Gold Fleet.

16.3 The Carmen Trophy will be awarded to the highest-placed visiting boat on the final overall series ranking list, excluding boats finishing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in the Gold Fleet.

16.4 Prizes will be awarded to the winning boat of each individual race. A boat shall not be awarded more than one individual race win prize during the regatta. If a race-winning boat has already won a race prize earlier in the series, the prize for that race will be awarded to the next highest-placed boat in that race who has not previously won a race prize.
